

General Information about course in Norwegian

Basic Norwegian

In the Basic Norwegian course the main focus will be on learning the basic structures and pronunciation of the Norwegian language. Each class follows the following general pattern:

1. Overview of a grammatical element.
2. Thereafter, we follow a text using this grammatical element. This is to train the element in a fixed structure, and show examples of it. In addition, you will in this part get training in your pronunciation.
3. In the end of each element we have tasks providing training in the elements we have gone through. This also includes both communication tasks and listening tasks.
4. Lastly, there is homework. **This part is extremely important.** The course follows the assumption that you not only do the tasks that are provided but also learn the vocabulary as we go along. The listening tasks will become very difficult if you do not quite remember most of the vocabulary. I do not check that you "have done your homework".

Intermediate Norwegian

To some extent the structure is similar as the course in Basic Norwegian. One fundamental difference, however, is that the classes center much more on topics. By default we follow the same topics and vocabulary you will find in a language class in Norway. This is particularly advisable for those who plan to take 'Bergenstesten'. We can use texts more suited for your individual interests, if you so wish. That being said, 'Bergenstesten' is quite complicated, so if passing this test is your aim, we should to a large extent "study for the test".

Modifiable course Layout:

All of the layouts mentioned below have flexibility based on individual needs. Some students prefer to start with the texts instead of the grammar. Still others prefer to study on their own and only have communications on particular topics. If you have special requests or preferences in way of learning, this can be accommodated.

Payment and terms

With the exception of the first class, all classes have to be paid prior to beginning of the class.
